

How to get from Warsaw Airport to Białystok

The most convenient way to travel from Warsaw Chopin Airport (WAW) to Białystok is by train. The journey typically takes around **2–2.5 hours** in total.

Step 1: From Warsaw Airport to the city center

Warsaw Chopin Airport is well connected to the city by train:

- Take a **SKM (urban rail)** or **Koleje Mazowieckie** train from the airport (station: *Warszawa Lotnisko Chopina*).
- Travel to one of the main railway stations:
 - Warszawa Centralna
 - Warszawa Zachodnia
- The journey takes approximately **20–30 minutes**.

Step 2: Train from Warsaw to Białystok

From Warszawa Centralna or Warszawa Zachodnia, take a direct train to Białystok operated by PKP Intercity.

- Travel time: approx. **1.5–2 hours** ([Rome2Rio](#))
- Direct trains run multiple times per day (roughly every 1–2 hours) ([Rome2Rio](#))
- First departures are early in the morning (~05:30–06:00), last in the evening (~20:30–21:00) ([EuroPodróże](#))

Alternative: Bus

You may also travel by long-distance bus (e.g., FlixBus), which typically takes around **2–3 hours** and may be cheaper, though less comfortable than the train ([Omio](#)).
